






Your union has negotiated the Joint Community Health Retraining Fund

to support skills upgrading, training and professional development for workers in the community health sector.

DEVELOPING WORKERS' SKILLS BUILDING HEALTHY COMMUNITIES



Training support of up to \$10,000 is available to individual workers for tuition, textbooks and other approved expenses.

You can apply at any time and receive an answer within 30 days. You can be reimbursed for courses you have already completed or started or courses you are interested in taking.

Relevant part and full time courses offered at public institutions in BC are eligible. In some circumstances, online courses, those offered at private institutions and those outside of BC may be considered. The Joint Community Health Retraining Fund supports courses relevant to community and facilitybased health care services. There are many different and interesting jobs in community health services and in health care facilities.

The retraining fund has already supported workers taking these courses:

- Computer Skills and Software
- Palliative Care Certificate
- Health Care Assistant
- English as a Second Language
- Skilled Trades carpenter, electrician, machinist, power engineer, HVAC and refrigeration, welder etc.
- Acute Care Skills for Home Support/ Resident Care Attendants
- Therapeutic Recreation
- Administrative and Bookkeeping
- Community Mental Health Worker
